Air Guns: All equipment must meet ISSF specifications when checked during the competition.

Course of Fire: Men & Jr. Men Two 60-shot matches - Aggregate of 120 shots

Women & Jr. Women Two 40-shot matches - Aggregate of 80 shots

Open Practice: Friday: ~18h00 – 19h00 (Dependent upon range availability)

Registration: Friday: Registration and gun check: 17h00 – 19h00

Saturday: Registration and gun check: 08h00 - 10h00
